As I have family living in the Bonawave Crescent Valley area of Nevada who are horrified at the possibility of dwelling in the immediate proximity of the proposed "revised Carlin Rail Route" meant to transport nuclear waste through Eureka County, I am urging you to find another place for it.

Please consider a route other than the one through Crescent Valley. The hot springs system to the east and seasonal lakes through the valley suggest an alternate route would be more feasible. Apparently, Lincoln County has indicated it would find such a rail line an economic enhancement. So why not put it there! It's certainly closer to Yucca Mt., the intended destination — in spite of lying in the proximity of numerous faults! I feel for all those in the vicinity.
